It has been and continues to be very much a labour of love. I still get a real kick out of seeing the years first Brimstone butterfly or Swallow returning from its Winter quarters. Taking photographs of our plants and animals is a real joy and one that I hope I can share with you by virtue of you using the image resources contained in this listing guide.

As you can well imagine it would be impossible to show examples of each of the subject areas detailed inside, so I decided that a list, albeit not by any means exhaustive, might be the best way to convey the breadth and depth of images that the library has to offer.

If you cannot find what you need within the listings, give me a call. The listings are just that, merely an idea, a taster of the range of species and habitats featured in the library. In addition to those plants and animals listed there may be a great many image permutations within a group or species.
